the 1987 landmark publications by g lakoff and m johnson made image schema one of the cornerstone concepts of the emerging experientialist paradigm of cognitive linguistics a framework founded upon the rejection of the mind body dichotomy and stressing the fundamentally embodied nature of meaning imagination and reason hence language conceived of as the pre linguistic dynamic and highly schematic gestalts arising directly from motor movement object manipulation and perceptual interaction image schemas served to anchor abstract reasoning and imagination to sensori motor patterns in the conceptual theory of metaphor being itself informed by preceding crosslinguistic work on semantic primitives in the linguistic representations of spatial relations carried out by l talmy r langacker and others the notion has inspired a large amount of subsequent research and debate on diverse issues ranging from the meaning structure and acquisition of natural languages to the embodied mind itself from perception to meaning is the first survey of current image schema theory and offers a collection of original and innovative essays by leading scholars many of whom have shaped the theory from the very beginning the edition unites essays on major issues in recent research on image schemas from aspects of their definition and linguistic formalization their psychological status and neural grounding to their role as semantic universals and primitives in language acquisition the book will thus not only be welcomed by linguists of a cognitive orientation but will prove relevant to philosophers psychologists and anthropologists interested in language and indeed to anyone studying the embodied mind

the origins of knowledge about the self is arguably the most fundamental problem of psychology it is a classic theme that has preoccupied great psychologists beginning with william james and freud on reading current literature today s developmental psychologists and ethologists are clearly expressing a renewed interest in the topic furthermore recent progress in the study of infant and animal behavior provides important and genuinely new insights regarding the origins of self knowledge this book is a collection of current theoretical views and research on the self in early infancy prior to self identification and the well documented emergence of mirror self recognition the focus is on the early sense of self of the young infant its aim is to provide an account of recent research substantiating the precursors of self recognition and self identification by concentrating on early infancy the book provides an updated look at the origins of self knowledge

in living in the landscape arnold berleant explores new ways of thinking about how we live and might live in the landscapes that enfold us through the concepts of aesthetic engagement and environmental continuity he proposes a new paradigm that offers a holistic approach to the meaning of place and places of meaning in our lives although environmental aesthetics is linked in the popular mind to dramatic vistas and monumental landscapes the grand canyon for example berleant is much more concerned with the commonplace settings of everyday life he argues that our active appreciation of or aesthetic engagement with the prosaic landscapes of home work local travel and recreation plays a vital role in our discovery of hidden continuities as well as pleasure and meaning in the places we inhabit berleant begins with a general introduction to environmental aesthetics identifying the kinds of experience meanings and values it involves and describing its historical sources and the issues with which it is concerned in the rest of the book he spotlights new directions in the field as they relate to education community creativity and the sacred and provides an insightful analysis of negative environmental aesthetics throughout he is both thoughtful and entertaining as evidenced in his extended critique of the pop post modern environment of disney world berleant addresses issues commonly associated with the environmental movement e g preservation pollution control and quality of life but his study draws from a wide range of disciplines and for that reason should also appeal to scholars and students interested in art and aesthetics landscape architecture and planning urban and environmental design and cultural geography as well as environmental studies

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
