books nine of which focused on the subject of prayer bounds was a practicing lawyer at age nineteen and after three years began preaching for the methodist episcopal church south at the time of his pastorate in brunswick missouri war was declared bounds became a prisoner of war after refusing to take the oath of allegiance to the federal government upon release he served as chaplain of the fifth missouri regiment until the close of the war
